

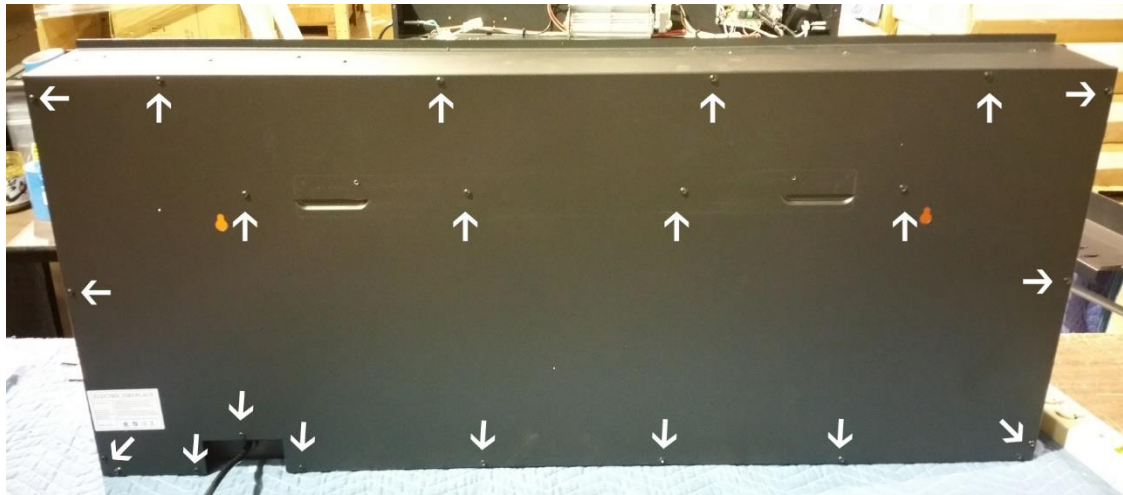
Checking LED Lights on Sideline Fireplace

Tools Needed:

- Phillips Screwdriver

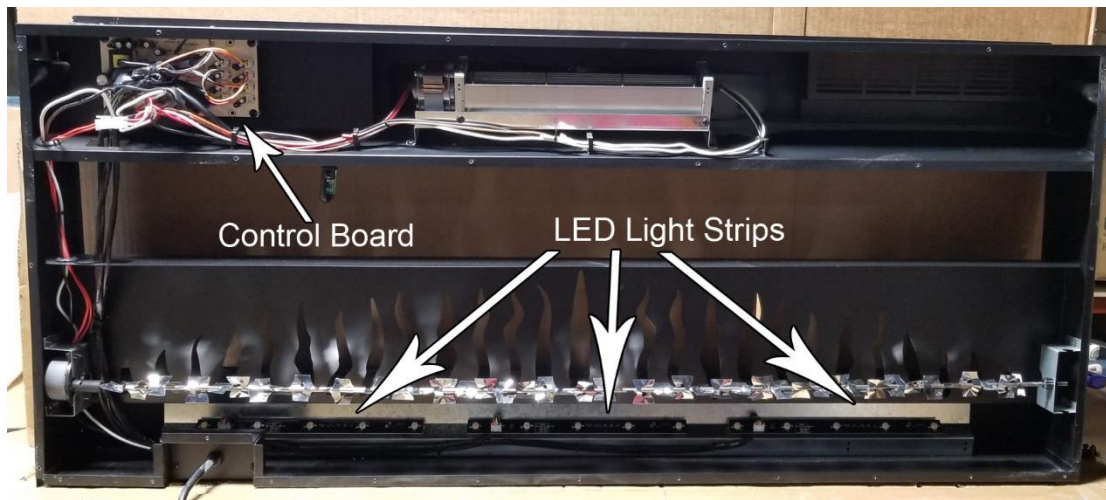
Instructions

1. Turn Off Sideline Fireplace.
2. Remove glass panel from fireplace and remove fireplace from wall.
3. Remove the screws from the rear of the fireplace. The picture below shows the 80004 – Sideline50 Fireplace. For units smaller than 50”, there will be less screws, but they will all be in the same general location as the arrows below. For units larger than 50”, there will be more screws.

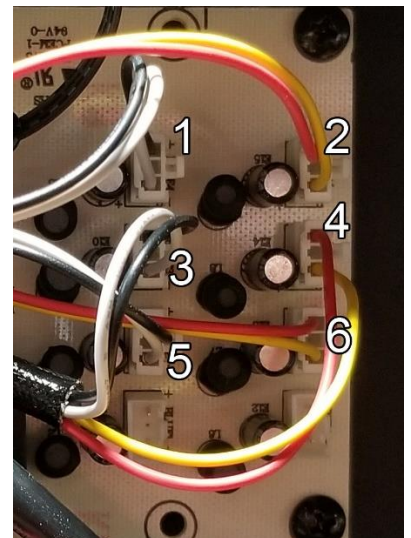
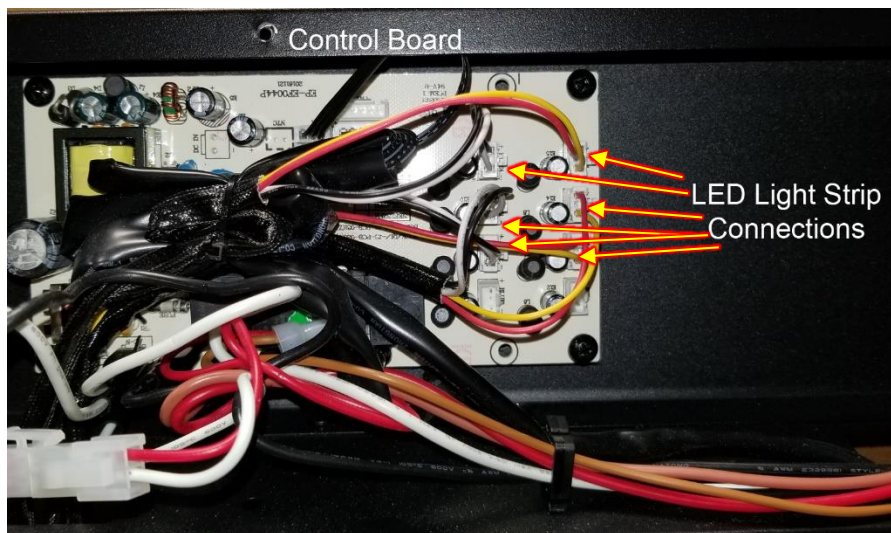


Inside of Fireplace with Back Panel Removed

4. Once the rear panel is removed, you will have access to the inside of the fireplace, including the control board and LED light strips.



5. Locate the control board in the upper left hand corner of the fireplace. Check each LED light strip cable to make sure that each cable is connected to the control board. There will be 2 connections per light strip.



6. Check the connection on each light strip to be sure that it is tight and connected to the light strip. The LED light strips are shown below.
